Introduction

Welcome to ETODOM Schools & Information Technology Centre! This booklet outlines the rules and expectations for all students to ensure a disciplined, respectful, and safe learning environment. Every student is required to adhere strictly to these rules.

1. Punctuality

- All students must arrive at school by 7:30 AM. Morning assembly begins at 7:45 AM.
- Latecomers must report to the office and present a valid reason before joining class.
- Attendance will be taken daily. Consistent lateness will attract disciplinary measures.

2. Dress Code and Cleanliness

- Students must wear the correct uniform as prescribed except otherwise instructed:
 - o Mondays & Wednesdays: Full school uniform.
 - Tuesdays & Thursdays: Sportswear
 - o Fridays: School Tee shirt.
- Uniforms must be clean and neatly always ironed.
- Shoes must be black, polished, and well-maintained.
- Hair must be neatly groomed. Boys should have a low cut, and girls' hair should be neatly plaited or tied.

3. Mode of Communication

- English Language is the only accepted means of communication within the school premises.
- Students must speak respectfully to teachers, staff, and fellow students.

4. Other Activities

- Wednesdays: Extra Curricular activities; 2pm 3pm
- Thursdays: Sports 10am -11am
- Fridays: Computer Practical 9:45am 11am, Fellowship 11:05am 11:35am

5. Examinations and Malpractice

- All students must maintain integrity during tests and examinations.
- Any form of examination malpractice cheating, spying, impersonation will attract strict penalties including suspension or expulsion.
- Students are expected to prepare ahead, seek help from teachers where necessary, and rely on their abilities.

6. Mannerisms

- Proper etiquette must be always observed.
- Students must address teachers and elders with respect.
- Disruptive behavior such as talking back, rude gestures, and defiance will not be tolerated.

7. Eating Times

- Eating is permitted only during break and lunch periods.
- No eating in classrooms, laboratories, or the library.
- Students must dispose of waste properly after eating.

8. Hygiene

- Personal hygiene must be always maintained.
- Students must keep their fingernails short and clean.
- Handwashing must be done before and after meals.
- Restrooms should be kept neat after use.

9. School Facilities

- Students must handle school property with care.
- Damaging school facilities, including desks, chairs, and electronic equipment, will result in penalties.
- Students must report any broken facilities to the appropriate authority.

10. Flowers and Greenery
